Committee Members Present: Margaret Morton, Chair of the Legislative & Games Committee; Douglas Dalena; James Heckman (joined at 10:43 a.m.); and Jerald Lentini (all via teleconference).

I. Welcome and Call to Order:

Ms. Morton called the meeting to order at 10:33 a.m.

II. Approval of May 11, 2026 Legislative and Games Committee Meeting Minutes:

On a motion by Mr. Lentini and seconded by Mr. Dalena, the minutes of the May 11, 2026 Legislative and Games Committee Meeting were unanimously approved.

III. Review and Possible Action: Powerball Xs and Os Game Rules:

Mr. Suarez provided an overview of a new multi-state jackpot game, Powerball Xs & Os, noting that game sales are expected to begin on September 8, 2026 with the first drawing on Sunday, September 13, 2026. The game is NFL-themed where rather than choosing numbers, players choose 8 NFL teams out of a total of 32 NFL teams hoping to match all 8 to win a rolling jackpot. The game is managed by the Powerball Xs & Os Product group of MUSL and as such the rules are similar to other games operated by MUSL with standard security, validation and prize claim rules.

After a brief discussion and on a motion by Mr. Lentini, seconded by Mr. Dalena and unanimously approved, it was:

Resolved, that after review and due consideration, the Legislative and Games Committee of the Connecticut Lottery Corporation's Board of Directors hereby approves and recommends that the Board of Directors approve the Powerball Xs & Os national game rules as presented, and authorizes CLC's staff to make any subsequent

minor edits, changes, or amendments as necessary to the national game rules or the CT Amendment, without the need for further approval or vote by the Committee.

IV. Adjournment:

Ms. Morton thanked everyone for their attendance.

On a motion made by Mr. Heckman, seconded by Mr. Dalena, and unanimously approved, the meeting adjourned at 10:44 a.m.
