II. Approval of Minutes:

III. New Business:

President's Report/Announcement

Ms. Noble welcomed and thanked Board members for attending today's meeting. Ms. Noble stated that she has been affiliated with the CT Lottery Corporation (CLC) for many years. When she first began, she drove a 2004 vehicle and her sons were just six and eight years old. She

Ms. Morton, having worked with Ms. Noble for many years, thanked her for all she has done during her tenure at the CLC and stated that the CLC has been wrapped with integrity since Ms. Noble arrived. "You are the best," stated Ms. Morton.

On motion made by Mr. Birney, seconded by Ms. Floyd, and unanimously approved, the meeting was adjourned at 5:10 p.m.
