Resolved, that, after review and due consideration, the Legislative and Games Committee recommends to the Board of Directors that the Board of Directors approves the changes made to the Connecticut Amendments associated with the Powerball, Mega Millions and Lucky for Life game rules, as well as the changes made to the game rules for Cash5, Keno, Lotto! and Play3/Play4, as presented.

Mr. Smith provided background information as it relates to the upcoming legislative session and noted that Mr. Mongillo is onboard and would be taking an active role in preparation for the session.
