I. Welcome and Call to Order:

II. Review of Draft 2026 Legislative Agenda:

Ms. Timbro provided a brief update of the 2026 Legislative Agenda noting that there was a General Law Committee public hearing on Wednesday, March 4, 2026 and Senate Bill 229 was discussed. There was good dialogue with members of the legislature and CLC is working with DCP and the tribes to agree on language. She also noted that CLC submitted written testimony opposing House Bill 5229. Details will be discussed during Executive Session.

On a motion by Ms. Morton, seconded by Mr. Heckman and unanimously approved, the Committee moved to Executive Session at 11:05 a.m. to discuss the following:
